
Dear Ms. Ioffe,

Schedule D of COX ALOMAR 2012 INC.'s July Quarterly Report erroneously shows under "Debts and Obligations" an outstanding debt of \$16,550 with Miguel Rios (d/b/a ME Sound) (pp.15-16 of 18).

The Committee's current outstanding debt with Miguel Rios, however, is of \$15,600. As both the Committee and Mr. Rios have acknowledged in all the pleadings and supporting documents filed in court in Puerto Rico (see enclosures), the Committee's original debt with Mr. Rios was of \$26,000 not \$26,950 as shown in previous Quarterly Reports. Since the end of the 2012 election cycle, the Committee has paid Mr. Rios \$10,400 (see enclosures) leaving \$15,600 outstanding --- not \$16,550 as listed therein.


Hence, we respectfully request leave to amend the Committee's July Quarterly Report accordingly.
