Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Schedule B (see attached) discloses one or more apparent contributions to a federal committee. However, on your Statement of Organization received on 8/30/10, you stated "This committee intends to make independent expenditures, and consistent with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit decision in SpeechNow v. FEC, it therefore intends to raise funds in unlimited amounts. This committee will not use those funds to make contributions, whether direct, in-kind, or via coordinated communications, to federal candidates or committees."

If any apparent contribution to a federal candidate or committee was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information.

Alternately, if your Committee is not an Independent Expenditure-Only Committee, please amend your Statement of Organization to clarify your committee type. (52 U.S.C. §30103(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. §433(b)) and 11 CFR §102.2)

Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding the apparent contribution to a federal candidate or committee, your prompt action will be taken into consideration.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
