


Dear Sirs:

We just received notice from the Federal Elections Commission that we have exceeded our contribution limit of \$5,000 when we sent you check #766, dated May 12, 1998, in the amount of \$1,000, designated for the primary election.

By way of background, the FEC requires WELLPAC contributions to be aggregated with those of BLUEPAC, the political action committee of the Blue Cross/Blue Shield Association. According to FEC reports, the aggregate contributions submitted by WELLPAC and BLUEPAC toward John Ensign's primary campaign fund totaled \$6500, with our check having the most recent date.

Accordingly, we are hereby redesignating check #766, in the amount of \$1,000, to your general election fund.
