This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Your amended report discloses additional disbursements totaling \$24,947.69 on Line(s) 23, 25, and 29 of the Detailed Summary Page that were not disclosed on your original report. Please provide clarifying information as to why this activity was not disclosed on your original report. 11 CFR §104.3

The Commission notes the attached Memo Text which states, in part, "Please note that some transactions were deleted and other added to the October Monthly report after a comprehensive audit and review of the original report. Some errors were made due to the unprecedented volume of activity disclosed in this report. After filing the report, committee staff reviewed the report and discovered several errors and filed an amended report as soon as possible after its review." Please provide any further clarifying information as to why this activity was not disclosed on your original report. 11 CFR §104.3

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
