
-Please provide a Schedule C or D, as appropriate, to support the entries of \$99,025.94 on the April Quarterly Report and \$106,772.16 on the July Quarterly Report, reported on Line 10 of the Summary Page(s). Loans and debts must be continuously reported until they are either repaid or settled. 11 CFR §104.3(d) Please note that it appears you have included the total cash on hand at the close of each reporting period from Line 8 as the total Debts and Obligations owed by the Committee on line 10. Please clarify whether this total represents the total amount of Debts and Obligations owed by your Committee or an amount listed on the wrong line.

**Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the

public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
