-The total listed on Line 20, Column B of the Detailed Summary Page appears to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Line 20, Column B total. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction. Note that the incorrect total on Line 20, Column B is affected by incorrect totals in Column B for Lines 11(a)(i), 11(a)(ii), 11(a)(iii), 11(d) and 17.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
