
Dear Mr. Davis:

I am writing in response to your letter dated February 19, 1997 regarding Tenet-PAC's 12 Day Pro-General Report regarding a contribution that had exceeded the \$5,000 limit to a candidate for federal office. The contributions in question were made to the "Mary Landrieu for Senate Committee," in the amount of \$5,000.00 on October 11, 1996 and \$5,000.00 on June 28, 1996. The June 28, 1996 disbursement was *incorrectly designated* for the General Election, rather than the Primary Election. The Louisiana Primary Election was held on September 21, 1996, and as such, the first contribution should have been designate for that election, not the General. The appropriate redesignation has been made to that itemized disbursement page and a complete copy of the related report (06/01/96-06/30/96) is attached.

Additionally, I have enclosed a copy of the letter Tenet-PAC has mailed to the "Mary Landrieu for Senate Committee" regarding this error and notifying that committee of the redesignation of the June 28, 1996 contribution as earmarked for the Primary Election rather than the General Election.

Thank you for bringing this error to my attention. I would appreciate the Federal Election Commission taking this prompt corrective action regarding this matter into consideration prior to taking any further legal action.


Please be advised that Tenet-PAC has recently been contacted by the Federal Election Commission regarding excessive campaign contributions to the Mary Landrieu for Senate Committee.

The contributions in question were made by Tenet-PAC on June 28, 1996 for \$5,000.00 and on October 11, 1996 for \$5,000.00. The June 28, 1996 disbursement was *incorrectly designated* on Tenet-PAC's July 20, 1996 monthly report as attributable to the General Election, rather than the Primary Election. The appropriate corrective action has been taken on our part and a copy of Tenet-PAC's corrected report is enclosed for your records, as well as a copy of our letter to the FEC explaining the error.

Dear Ms. Limon:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule B of your report (pertinent portion(s) attached) discloses a contribution(s) which appears to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(a) precludes a multicandidate committee from making a contribution to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$5,000 per election.

If the contribution(s) in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with clarifying information. If you have made an excessive contribution, you should notify the recipient and request a refund of the amount in excess of \$5,000 and/or notify the recipient in writing of your redesignation of the contribution. In the best interest of your committee, all refunds and redesignations should be made within sixty days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution(s).


Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of the refund request sent to the candidate(s). In addition, any refunds should be disclosed on Schedule A supporting Line 16 of the report covering the period during which they are received. Any redesignations should be disclosed as memo entries on

Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the report covering the period during which the redesignation is made. 11 CFR §110.2(b)

Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding the excessive contribution(s), your prompt action in obtaining a refund and/or redesignating the contribution(s) will be taken into consideration.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
