For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, other disbursements, such as non-federal contributions, should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule B, supporting Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page, and refunds to political committees should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule B, supporting Line 28(c) of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C §434(b)) and FORM 3X Instructions)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to
