On November 26, 2012, ActBlue responded to Requests for Additional Information regarding our 2012M6 and 2012M7 reports with a Form 99-Miscellaneous Submission to the FEC. Due to the number of issues to which we were responding, we neglected to respond entirely to questions raised about earmarked contributions being disbursed outside the ten-day window for doing so. We apologize for the oversight.

Our previous response did not address contributions that had been earmarked for Women on the Road to the Senate 12 and Counting - New York City (C00519462) and Women on the Road to the Senate 12 and Counting - Washington DC (C00519470). We received contributions earmarked for these committees beginning on April 24, 2012 (in the case of the New York committee) and May 1, 2012 (in the case of the Washington committee). At the time that we received these contributions, we did not have on file a mailing address for these committees. Without mailing addresses, we were unable to print and send checks forwarding the earmarked contributions. We received a mailing address for the New York committee on May 9, and for the Washington committee on May 14. We then forwarded the contributions on the following day on which we printed checks, which was May 13 for the New York committee and May 20 for the Washington committee.

ActBlue apologizes for the error. With the many, many earmarked contributions we have received and disbursed, this has been an extremely rare occurrence, and we are confident that it will not happen in the future.
