

Dear Mr. Jones:

This form 99 is in response to your letter of October 15, 2008 where you raised concerns about three main issues. Sections 1 & 2 in regards to expenditures, and Section 3 in regards to a contribution made to a Presidential campaign.

In Section 1 the expenditures made for 'Gold prize money' were a few miscellaneous prizes provided for high score golfers. These prizes included golf shirts, putters, sets of golf balls, golf bag, tees, practice putter sets, golf hats, golf towels, and golf gloves.

In Section 2 the expenditures made for 'Golf course fees for event' is for expenses charged from the hosting site the Maryland National Golf Club and their fee included payment for greens fees, associated golf fees and for the food, and drink provided at the event.

In Section 3 in regards to a contribution made to a Presidential campaign. The contribution was made after the Presidential primary election cycle and at that time the candidate was not receiving public funding to our knowledge. If this is not the case then every action will be taken to comply with the Commission's rules and regulations.

Thank you for bringing these concerns to our attention. I hope this clears up any confusion with our account. If not please do not hesitate to contact us.
