After investigating this matter, the Committee determined that the Longhorn PAC contribution was erroneously reported. The contribution was actually received in Washington, DC on February 11, 2014, and then was mailed and received by another campaign agent in Texas on February 18 for deposit into the account. That explains the discrepancy in the dates; the campaign mistakenly reported the date as February 18. We have amended the pre-primary report to show the contribution on Feb. 11, and removed it from the Q1 report.

The contribution reported from Janice Pierson was actually an in-kind contribution. This apparently was simply a mistake in recordkeeping on this occasion. The contribution was mistakenly reported as a monetary instead of in-kind contribution; this was corrected on the amended Q1 report. The Committee will review its procedures to ensure that in-kind contributions are reported as in-kind. The Committee has regularly reported in-kind contributions correctly; it appears this one simply was the result of an error. Additionally, the Committee will ensure that any in-kind contributions are included with future 48-hour reports.
