On March 11, 1999, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your March 22, 1999, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Schedule H4 of your report discloses an activity that is also reported as a 100% federal activity on Schedule F. Please be advised that a 100% federal activity does not by definition qualify as a shared expense to be allocated between your federal and non-federal accounts. This activity should only be itemized on a Schedule F for Line 25 of the Detailed Summary Page. Any reimbursement from your committee's non-federal account for any portion of this activity is not permissible and must be returned. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
