This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. 1. The totals listed on Line(s) 6(a), 6(c), 11(a)(iii), 11(e), 13(a), 13(c), and 16, Column B of the Summary and Detailed Summary Page(s) appear to be incorrect. Column B figures for the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages should equal the sum of the Column B figures on your previous report and the Column A figures on this report. Please file an amendment to your report to correct the Column B discrepancies for this report and all subsequent report(s) which may be affected by this correction. Note that Column B should reflect only the election cycle-to-date totals (11/5/08 through 11/4/14). (2 U.S.C. § 434(b) and 11 CFR § 104.3)
2. Commission Regulations require the continuous reporting of all outstanding loans. (11 CFR §§ 104.3(d) and 104.11) This report omits the loan(s) itemized on your previous report(s). Please amend your report(s) to indicate the current status of the following loan(s):
