This is in response to your letter of August 5 concerning the July Quarterly Report recently filed by the Motorists Mutual Insurance Company Civic Fund. You specifically requested clarification of the June 4, 1998 receipt of \$18,859.86 from the Motorists Insurance Civic Fund.

As background, in 1994 Motorists Mutual Insurance Company created the original Motorists Insurance Civic Fund (MICF) which was a state/local PAC only. In 1998, the company saw the need to support political candidates at the federal level, and thus created a federal PAC, the Motorists Mutual Insurance Company Civic Fund (MMICCF). Our plan was to terminate the original state/local PAC and transfer its funds to the new federal PAC (MMICCF).

When we created the original state PAC in 1994, we opened a checking account to handle contributions and expenses. When we created the new, federal PAC earlier this year, we opened a separate checking account for it, and transferred the bulk of the funds held by the original PAC to the new PAC. This is the \$18,859.86 transaction of June 4, 1998 that you are questioning. We kept some funds in the original account to cover outstanding checks and potential expenses incurred before we terminated the MICF PAC. On July 14, 1998, the final transfer of funds to the new PAC was made and the original checking account was closed. With the closing of the original account, we are now in a position to terminate the state/local PAC. Accordingly, enclosed is a copy of the termination report that will be filed with the Ohio Secretary of State's office. Please advise if you desire a date/time-stamped copy of this report.

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At this time, we have only one PAC and one checking account in force. It is our intent to operate the federal Motorists Mutual Insurance Company Civic Fund as discussed in 11 CFR 102.5(a)(1)(ii).
