-Schedule H2 indicates the allocation ratio for Al Gore Fundraiser (GORE 98) was revised during the reporting period. Please provide the date on which this revision became effective. In the event that an excessive non-federal transfer was received, the excessive amount should be transferred back to your non-federal account.

-Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Transfers to your non-federal account for a non-federal overpayment of a shared activity should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule H4, supporting Line 21a of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions contained on the forms to determine the proper categorization when preparing your next filing.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Please clarify all expenditures made for Advertising, TV Production, TV Buy and Afr-american radio on Schedule H4. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedule B or F supporting Line 23 or 25 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1

-Please clarify all expenditures for "voter registration" and "get-out-the-vote". In addition, if any of the voter registration or get-out-the-vote activities referenced House or Senate candidates, they should be allocated accordingly, unless merely incidental to the overall activity. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of federal candidates, they should be reported on Schedule B or F for Line 23 or 25 of the Detailed Summary Page, as appropriate.
