On June 24, 1998, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your July 7, 1998, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Your report discloses a payment(s) on Schedule D to Chuck Sigerson, which has not been recorded on a disbursement schedule. Debt payments must be reflected on Schedule B or H4 as well as on Schedule D. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(5)(D)

-The \$3,510.82 transferred from the non-federal account for the Dolc Event has been removed from Schedule H3 as have the disbursements made for this event on Schedule H4. However, Schedule H2 still shows the allocation ratio for this event. Please note that a 100% non-federal fundraising event does not fall within the definitions of an allocable expense. Please clarify this discrepancy.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
