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On 2.1.2012, the Democratic Party of Wisconsin received a Request for Additional Information. We were asked to address eight specific items. Our responses are outline below:

1. Column B figures have been corrected.

2. Corrected.

3. The disbursement description to Nate Schwantes originally listed as ?sa? on our Schedule H4 was a typo. The correct description should be listed as ?salary.?

4. Schedule H4 supporting line 21(a) of our report discloses payments for ?Brochure printing,? ?sign printing,? and ?signs printing.? These communications did not clearly identify a candidate for Federal office and do not meet the definition of Federal Election Activity or activities in connection with a federal election. Additionally, they do not contain express advocacy, and do not constitute an in-kind contribution, an independent expenditure or a coordinated party expenditure.

5. All reimbursement memos are present in new amendment.

6. All ADP salary memos are present in the new amendment. There are additional disbursements to ADP for payroll-processing that do not have memos attached, as they are not required. These are simply fees to ADP for payroll processing.

7. Schedule H4 of our report discloses payments for ?Intern Stipend.? These expenditures do not represent reimbursements to any individuals for travel or other expenditures.

8. On Schedule H4 the expenditures made for ?Robo Surveys? were expenditures that were not made for activity that promotes or opposes a Federal candidate. ?Robo Surveys? are electronic telephone surveys conducted to gage public opinion or gather information. Again, these particular surveys conducted in May were not used on Federal Election Activity or any activities in connection with a Federal election or Federal candidate.
