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This letter is in response to the Commission's request for additional information in regards to the Committee's 2012 Year End Report.

1. The Committee did not over transfer the non federal share of disbursements on Schedule H. The Commission based thier calculations on a three month period, which does not take into account the 60 day post disbursement transfer window. Transfers made in October may contain expenses as far back as August, which are not included in the Commission's calculations. All transfers are calculated useing the Committee's compliance software, which does not allow for over transferring funds.
2. The Commission notes a transfer on Schedule H5 for Generic Campaign Activity. This is not correct. The transfer was for GOTV Activity and was reported as such on the original report.
3. The reports for the last quarter of 2012 do not report any disbursements for payroll related items on Schedule B, supporting Line 30b, because no employee spent over 25% of thier compensated time on federal activity. The Committee was focused on state legislative races during this period.

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
