Dear Mr. Beckman:

I serve as campaign counsel to the above named committee, and write in response to the request for additional information dated April 14, 2019. The request notes that the committee may have failed to timely file one or more required 24 Hour Last Minute Independent Expenditure Reports.

On October 19, 2018, the committee filed a 24-Hour Report disclosing a number of estimated independent expenditures based on all known information at the time of filing. On the initial filing, the committee disclosed \$150,660 in estimated payments to the Million Voter Project Action Fund for a phone banking and walk program from October 18, 2018 through November 6, 2018. Based on the work that the committee anticipated in connection with those payments, the payments were allocated to support TJ Cox, Katie Hill, and Mike Levin, and oppose David Valadao and Steve Knight.

The estimated payments to the Million Voter Project Action Fund increased from the initial \$150,660 estimate to \$171,244. In addition, the phone banking and walk program was expanded to include communications supporting Gil Cisneros and Harley Rouda, and opposing Young Kim and Dana Rohrabacher. As soon as the committee was aware of the increased level of activity from what was initially reported, and the need to allocate the expenditures to four additional candidates, the committee amended the October 19, 2018 filing to add this information. The initial report was amended on November 5, 2018 in advance of the election.

On December 4, 2018 the committee received in-kind contribution information indicating that another entity, Service Employees International Union United Service Workers West (SEIU USWW) provided staff-time, travel expenses and phone banking expenses as an in-kind contribution to the committee. Because this information was not received until after the election, it was not disclosed on a 24 or 48 Hour Report. While this information was not disclosed on a 24 or 48 Hour Report because it was received following the election, the committee substantially complied with all required 24-Hour and 48-Hour filing obligations, filing estimates of its expenditures where needed to ensure that its expenditures for various ongoing field activities were disclosed in advance of the election
