Dear Mr. Webster:

On September 19, 2001, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your October 4, 2001, response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-It appears that your report contains financial activity that should have been disclosed on your 1999 October Quarterly Report covering the period between 7/01/99 and 9/30/99. Overlapping coverage dates create difficulties in accounting for cash flow from one report to another. The Commission is in receipt of your amended report dated September 28, 2001. Your report continues to disclose overlapping coverage dates. Please amend your 1999 Year End Report by including only the financial transactions that occurred between 10/01/99 and 12/31/99. Any activity occurring outside this reporting period should be included in the appropriate reports.


An adequate response must be received at the Commission by October 31, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of

the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
