Thank you for the Request For Additional Information letter dated February 5, 2018 regarding the National Campaign PAC's TERMINATION REPORT (07/01/2017 - 12/31/2017).

The RFAI letter stated that some employer and occupation entries appeared on the Committees report that are not considered acceptable. The letter noted that the Committee had previously submitted a description of its best efforts procedures. The RFAI letter stated that the Committees follow-up requests for contributor information: did not include a pre-addressed postcard or return envelope, was not made within 30 days of receiving the contribution, and did not indicate that you would update your reports to include the missing information.

I will provide some additional information here about the process that was used to send follow-up requests for contributor information that I believe will indicate that National Campaign followed the FECs requirements for best efforts.

As the Committees letter dated September 27, 2017 regarding best efforts procedures stated, the best effort letter sent by the Committee requesting additional information from individuals who contributed in excess of \$200 in an election cycle and who had provided incomplete information is accompanied by a form and pre-addressed return envelope that the contributor can use to easily submit the legally required information to the committee.

Regarding other particulars of the process not explained in the Committees September 27, 2017 letter regarding best efforts procedures, the Committees best efforts letters requesting information were sent on a weekly basis as individuals contribution levels exceed the \$200 per election cycle threshold. New information from replies to the best efforts were entered into the database so that the most complete information could be reported on the Committees campaign finance reports. Additionally, if we receive contributor information after a contribution has been reported we either amend the appropriate report or we file the information with our next regularly scheduled report as an amended memo Schedule A listing all the contributions for which the requested information was received.
