Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Schedule A of your report discloses contributions from political committees that fail to include a full and/or recognizable name. Reporting only the name of the connected organization, abbreviating the name of the committee so it is unrecognizable, using an indistinguishable acronym, or using an unofficial nickname is inadequate. The following committee names from your report need further clarification: "Battleground Victory JFC." The Commission notes the Memo text attached to your report which states, "The receipts originally reported as coming from the Democratic National Committee have been corrected to show that they actually came from the Committee for Change." Two receipts originally reported by your committee as received from the "Democratic National Committee" have been reported as received from "Battleground Victory JFC" on this amendment.

Please amend your report to disclose the correct name of the source of these transfers. 11 CFR §§100.12, 102.14(c) and 104.3(a)(4)(ii)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
