Dear Ms. Sagri:

Thank you for your letter of October 29, 2004 seeking clarifying information as to why the receipts totaling \$15,000 for June 9, 2004 were not reported in our original July quarterly report. As was discussed with you by our assistant treasurer Scott Diamond over the telephone just prior to our filing the amended report on September 15, 2004, this was a unique circumstance given the timing of the contributions and the departure of our former treasurer.

On June 4-6, 2004, the partners of Robins, Kaplan, Miller & Ciresi L.L.P. held their quarterly business meeting. The receipts totaling \$15,000 and reported in our amended quarterly report are the result of that meeting. At the same time, partner Harold Mexicow, longtime treasurer of the PAC was in the process of leaving the law firm. Unfortunately, he and the other partners who oversee the management of the PAC failed to inform our assistant treasurer of this transaction. It was also around this time that I assumed formal responsibilities as treasurer of the PAC, but, I was unaware that the receipts had actually been deposited into the PAC account. Nor at the time of preparing our quarterly filing had we received the June 2004 monthly statement from our depository bank. Thus, our original July quarterly filing did not disclose the receipt of \$15,000.

While we believe that this was a unique and one time circumstance which will not occur again, we do realize and take seriously the fact that it resulted in an unintentional filing of incomplete data with the FEC. We apologize for this oversight. And, realizing a weakness in our internal communication and accounting system for the PAC, we have since put in place measures to avoid a repeat of this scenario.
