The Committee responds to the two Requests for Additional Information dated May 6, 2018 as follows:

30 Day Post Special Report-

The following independent expenditures were filed as monthly estimates and the committee did not spend funds related to the budgeted activity for that period.

- Brilliant Communications (Dissem. 12/1/17)- \$15,000
- Connell Donatelli, Inc. (Dissem. 12/1/17)- \$5,000
- Message Made Easy (Dissem. 12/1/17)- \$5,000
- Right Country Lists (Dissem. 12/1/17)- \$5,000
- Right Country Lists (Dissem. 1/1/18)- \$10,000

As related to the estimate filed for Connell Donatelli, Inc. disseminating 1/1/18, the committee filed separate 48 hour reports as invoices were paid during the reporting period and no additional payments needed to be applied towards the estimate.

Additionally, while there were two payments made to Message Made Easy in February 2018 for communications that disseminated in January 2018, these communications related to the ongoing work of Message Made Easy as a (previously and repeatedly reported) sub-vendor of another vendor, Infocision Management Corporation. Those payments were reported on the 2018 March Monthly with appropriate memo text linking them to the Infocision Management Corporation estimate. The Committee had anticipated a separate project, independent of that regular and ongoing campaign, from Message Made Easy, but that did not occur and therefore no payment was made to or services performed that would need to be applied towards this estimate.

February Monthly Report-

1.The Committee mistakenly failed to report the independent expenditure to Rapid Response Television, LLC that disseminated 1/31/18 on a 48 hour report at the time of dissemination. The committee discovered this error during the monthly report reconciliation process and promptly reported it on a 48 hour report dated 2/14/18 (FEC- 1208506).

2.In regards to best efforts on behalf of the committee to collect employer and occupation information, all contributors are asked to provide this information at the time of solicitation and then subsequently receive a postcard or email asking for name, address, employer, and occupation if it was not initially provided. The Committee has not been provided any additional information from the contributors in question in order to be able to provide a further update to the Commission. Additionally, the employer and occupations provided by Mr. Van Amerongen and Mr. Parsons are what was provided to the Committee and reported to the Commission per their request.
