Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Your amended report discloses additional receipts totaling \$53,627 on Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page that were not disclosed on your original report. The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, "Due to an issue with the reporting software, contributions raised as earmarks by the American Solutions PAC for other federal committees were not accurately disclosed on the original pre-general report filed on 10/21/10. This amendment reflects all earmarks received from 10/1-10/13/10. This was not income for the Committee. Please note that only a small portion of the earmarks were transmitted to the recipient committees during this reporting period. All other transmittals, made within the 10 day requirement, will be reflected on the post-general report." Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
