Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 item(s):

1. On Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i), your committee disclosed a contribution(s) from "Bracco, Paul" with an aggregate year-to-date total(s) which is greater than the total receipts disclosed from this individual. Please provide clarifying information or amend the report covering the period during which the omitted transaction(s) occurred. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) and 11 CFR §104.3(a)(4))
2. Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of your report discloses receipts identified as "Unitemized Contributions." Please be advised that federal regulations require the itemization of all contributions from individuals/persons that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. Contributions from individuals/persons that aggregate \$200 or less need only be disclosed on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Detailed Summary Page.

Please clarify whether the receipts disclosed on Schedule A includes any contributions that aggregate greater than \$200 from an individual/person in the calendar year. If this is the case, please amend your report by itemizing the contributions from each individual/person on Schedule A. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(2))

3. On Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) and 29, you have itemized disbursements for which you have failed to include the purpose. Please amend your report to include the missing information. (11 CFR § 104.3(b)(3))

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4. Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses operating expenditures identified as "Unitemized Disbursements." Please be advised that federal regulations require the itemization of all operating expenditures that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. Please clarify whether the operating expenditures disclosed on Schedule B includes any disbursements to an entity that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. If this is the case, please amend your report by itemizing the operating expenditures or provide an explanation for this discrepancy. (11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(i))

- On Schedule(s) A of your report you have disclosed a transaction(s) for \$0.00. For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, only transactions with an actual monetary value should be itemized on your report. If the amount for this transaction(s) was entered in error, please amend your report to include the correct amount(s). (11 CFR §104.3)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
