This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Please be advised that for each earmarked contribution forwarded must provide the information required by 11 CFR §110.6(c)(1)(iv)(A) through (C). Schedule B, Line 23 discloses earmarked contributions totaling \$30,100 forwarded to the "Adam Schiff," "Barbara Bollier," "Cal Cunningham," "Donald McEachin," "Doug Jones," "Elaine Luria," "Elissa Slotkin," "Gary Peters (Senate)," "Gerry Connolly," "Hakeem Jeffries," "Jeanne Shaheen," "Jennifer Wexton," "Mark Kelly," "Mark Warner," "Sara Gideon," "SHARICE DAVIDS," "Steve Bullock (Senate)," "Theresa Greenfield," and "XOCHITL TORRES SMALL." Pursuant to 11 CFR §110.6(c), all earmarked contributions, that have passed through a conduit's account, must be itemized on the receipt (Schedule A) and disbursement (Schedule B) schedules, regardless of the amount. On your report, the dates of the forwarded earmarks on Schedule B are preceding the dates of the receipts on Schedule A. Please clarify this discrepancy and provide the exact date the earmarked contribution was received by your committee (Schedule A) and forwarded to the recipient candidate (Schedule B).

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will**


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**not be considered.**
