This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Schedule B of your amended April Monthly report discloses a redesignated contribution to Mark Baker for Congress for the 2000 General election campaign; however, this does not appear to be disclosed properly or clearly on the public record. Please be advised that redesignated contributions should be disclosed as memo entries. In addition, if a contribution to a candidate is redesignated after the close of books, the redesignation should be disclosed in the reporting period during which the redesignation occurred. Please amend your report and refer to the enclosed sample of properly reported redesignated contributions.

Redesignations of Contributions

Use memo entries to show any redesignations of contributions.

If a contribution to a candidate is redesignated after the close of books, show the redesignation on the next report and indicate the report on which the original contribution was itemized.

In this illustration, the committee originally made a \$10,000 contribution to a candidate's campaign, intending half of it to count toward the general election. The committee itemized the contribution in its April quarterly report. The following month, the campaign requested that the SSF redesignate the excessive \$5,000 for the general election campaign. The committee itemized the redesignation in its July quarterly report.
