

This is in response to the letter dated 7/20/07 referencing the May Monthly Report (4/01/07-4/30/07):

- 1. Regarding missing occupation information for individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year: The committee's procedure for obtaining the information is as follows: All of our original solicitations include a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor information and inform the contibutors of the requirement of federal law. If the donor has not provided the information, the committee will either call or send a letter with return envelope to the donor asking for the occupation with no solicitation and again inform the contibutor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information. This is done within 30 days after the contribution is received. Contributor information received after the contribution has been reported is then filed as an amendment memo with the next regularly scheduled report.
- 2. All individuals whose occupation/employer is identified as "Information Requested Information Requested" or "Self Employed Builder" have been sent a letter as described in #1 above and information received will be filed as an amendment memo with the next regularly scheduled report.
- 3. None of the expenditures made for 'Envelope printing not FEA', 'Finance mailing not FEA', and 'Fundraising consulting' were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates.
