Dear Mr. Ryan:

I am in receipt of your letter of April 5, 1996, stating that NAAA PAC's Statement of Organization may not comply with 11 CFR §102.14(c) because "the name of a separate segregated fund . . . shall include the full name of its connected organization." The letter goes on to say that Commission records indicate that the name of our connected organization is the National Association of Arab Americans, Inc., and requests that the political committee's Statement of Organization be amended accordingly.

I am writing in response to request that the Commission's records be corrected to reflect that the name of the "connected" organization in this instance is "NAAA, Inc." — not "National Association of Arab Americans, Inc." The organization was incorporated as "NAAA, Inc." in the District of Columbia in 1983 (a copy of page 1 of the Articles of Incorporation is enclosed herewith). NAAA, Inc.'s segregated fund — NAAA PAC — does, therefore, include the full name of its connected organization.

Thank you for your assistance in correcting the records of the above-referenced political committee.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NAAA, INC.

To: The Recorder of Deeds, D.C.
Washington, D.C.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators for such corporation adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation pursuant to the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act:

I. NAME

The name of the Corporation is NAAA, Inc.

II. DURATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

III. PURPOSES

A. The Corporation is organized exclusively for the promotion of social weifare, more specifically the following:

1. To provide a national structure within which Arab Americans may express and act upon their shared concerns.

2. To coordinate public concern for world peace into specific action for the development of international
