In regard to your letter Reference: 30-DAY POST-GENERAL REPORT (10/14/2010-11/22/2010) dated September 29, 2011 and a conversation with our FEC analyst on November 14, 2011:

1. Disbursements on schedule B, line 30 (b) for 'non-allocable mail' meet the conditions of exempt activity. Volunteers had substantial involvement with each mail piece.
2. Amendments have been made to the 30-DAY POST-GENERAL REPORT to further clarify which federal candidates the non-allocable mailings listed on schedule B, line 30(b) were attributable to.
3. No transfers from the Republican National Committee were used to pay for the non-allocable mailings.
4. The disbursement to Advanced Mail Inc. on 10/29/2010 was for generic slate materials and therefore is not allocable to a specific candidate(s).
5. An inadvertent error was made in the purpose description for the disbursements to Public Opinion Strategies, LLC on 10/22/2010 and 11/01/2010. These disbursements were for 'polling - voter ID' and were not allocable to any specific candidate.
6. An amendment has been made to the 2010 Year End Report to reflect correct cash on hand figures at the beginning and closing of the reporting period.
