In regard to your letter Reference: 30-DAY POST-GENERAL REPORT (10/14/2010-11/22/2010) dated September 29, 2011 and a conversation with our FEC analyst on November 14, 2011:

- 1. Disbursements on schedule B, line 30 (b) for 'non-allocable mail' meet the conditions of exempt activity. Volunteers had substantial involvement with each mail piece.
- 2. Amendments have been made to the 30-DAY POST-GENERAL REPORT to further clarify which federal candidates the non-allocable mailings listed on schedule B, line 30(b) were attributable to.
- 3. No transfers from the Republican National Committee were used to pay for the non-allocable mailings.
- 4. The disbursement to Advanced Mail Inc. on 10/29/2010 was for generic slate materials and therefore is not allocable to a specific candidate(s).
- 5. An inadvertent error was made in the purpose description for the disbursements to Public Opinion Strategies, LLC on 10/22/2010 and 11/01/2010. These disbursements were for 'polling voter ID' and were not allocable to any specific candidate.
- 6. An amendment has been made to the 2010 Year End Report to reflect correct cash on hand figures at the beginning and closing of the reporting period.
