

The following is an explanation of the immediate corrective action taken by the U.S.-Cuba Democracy PAC ("PAC") pursuant to a request for additional information by the FEC (dated April 15th, 2009) on three items in the Amended 2008 April Quarterly Report:

1. The PAC incorrectly disclosed a January 2nd, 2008 contribution as received from BankUnited, A Savings Bank Political Action Committee. The PAC had intended to disclose the contribution from BankUnited, A Federal Corporation Political Action Committee, which is an authorized political committee registered with the FEC. The incorrect disclosure resulted from a clerical oversight due to the almost identical names of the committees. The PAC has further amended the 2008 April Quarterly Report to correctly reflect the registered contributor.
2. On February 6th, 2008, the PAC made a \$2,500 contribution to the federal campaign of "Engel, Eliot." Due to a clerical oversight, the PAC incorrectly disclosed this contribution for the 2008 Primary election. The PAC had intended the contribution to be disclosed for the 2008 General election. The recipient committee had correctly disclosed the contribution for the 2008 General election. The correction has been made by the PAC and further amended in the 2008 April Quarterly Report. The cumulative total contributed by the PAC to this campaign for the 2008 Primary and General election was below the legal amount permitted by the FEC.
3. The FEC notified the PAC of six contributions to the campaigns of federal candidates that were incorrectly disclosed -- due to a clerical oversight -- as contributions for the 2008 Primary election after the primary election date.

Five of the contributions were in the State of Illinois:

The PAC had intended for these contributions to be disclosed for their 2008 General elections. All of the recipient committees had correctly disclosed these contributions for their 2008 General elections. The corrections have been made by the PAC and further amended in the 2008 April Quarterly Report. The amounts contributed by the PAC for both the 2008 Primary and the 2008 General of each of these campaigns were well below the legal amounts permitted by the FEC.
