This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:

1. Your report discloses outstanding balances beginning this period for debts owed to "CATTERTON PRINTING INC" and "MDI IMAGING & MAIL." However, outstanding balances at the close of the period were not disclosed on your April Quarterly Report (1/1/08-3/31/08). Please amend your reports to clarify this discrepancy.
2. Schedule D of your report discloses debts owed to "CATTERTON PRINTING INC" and "MDI IMAGING & MAIL" with negative beginning balances. Please provide further clarification regarding the obligation owed to these vendors or amend your report to disclose the correct amount owed.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
