Dear Ms. Ioffe:

On behalf of my client Robin Tallon, I write in response to your letter of May 29, 2019 regarding the above referenced matter. You have requested various pieces of information regarding Mr. Tallon's campaign committee during the period of July - December 2018, and we are happy to provide that information for you in this letter.

As an initial matter and as I am sure you are aware, there is no legal prohibition for a former officeholder to keep his or her campaign committee open after leaving office, nor is there an explicit deadline to close down that committee. Of course, a former officeholder's committee may file a termination report at any time, but he or she is not required by law to do so.

With regard to the specific information you have requested, this is to confirm that the expenditures in July 2018 for postage and legal services (items #1129 and 1430) were made on behalf of the committee. The postage was for mailing committee-related materials to the campaign treasurer, and the legal services was for advice sought pertaining to the committee and the campaign account. As a result, no amendments or reimbursements are required.

Moreover, the residual funds balance in the campaign account is the result of shrewd investments made on behalf of the committee. All of the disbursements during the time period requested were for legitimate expenditures related to the campaign account, mostly regarding postage expenses for mail to the FEC and the IRS, banking expenses for the campaign account, and legal fees related to the campaign. The FEC Form 3's for the relevant time period reflect these expenditures.

As for the current status of the candidate and committee, this is to confirm that Mr. Tallon is actively contemplating a return to public office in some capacity, and he is routinely encouraged
