Dear Mr. Lane:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Line 11(a)(1) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$6,860.60 in Column A, Contributions from Individuals. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$6,292.36. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Schedule B of your report discloses earmarked contributions. If the contribution passed through your committee's account, each must be itemized on the receipt and expenditure schedules, regardless of the amount. For disclosure purposes, the name and mailing address for each contributor must be provided, and where the contribution exceeds \$200, the individual's occupation and name of employer must also be itemized. (11 CFR §110.6(c)(1)(v)) Please amend your report accordingly.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
