On September 25, 1996 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your October 2, 1996 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The Commission acknowledges your contribution designation of debt retirement for the primary election for the Mascara for Congress Committee; however, that committee does not have **Net Debts Outstanding** from the primary election. Citing 11 CFR §110.2(b)(3)(i), "A contribution designated in writing for a particular election, but made after that election, shall be made only to the extent that the contribution does not exceed net debts outstanding from such election..." Please amend your report to reflect the correct designation for your contribution to the Mascara for Congress Committee and disclose any necessary redesignations or refunds on the appropriate report.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
