NOTICE SUPPORTING ADVANCE-ATTACHMENT

I.

According to Article 1, Section (§) 8, Clause 1, of the U.S. Constitution, "The Congress SHALL have POWER...to pay the DEBTS and provide for the common Defense and general Welfare of the United States".

II.

Pursuant to Article 1 § 8, Clause 3, of the U.S. Constitution the Congress SHALL have POWER "To regulate COMMERCE... and among the several States".

III.

The Congress SHALL have POWER, "To establish...UNIFORM laws on the subject of Bankruptcies throughout the United States", and this POWER is vested by Article 1 § 8, Clause 4, of the U.S. Constitution.

IV.

The Congress SHALL have POWER..."To constitute Tribunals inferior to the Supreme Court", by POWER vested in Article 1 § 8, Clause 9, of the U.S. Constitution.

V.

The Congress SHALL have POWER..."To EXERCISE exclusive Legislation in ALL Cases whatsoever...", by POWER vested in Article 1 § 8, Clause 17 of the U.S. Constitution.

VI.

According to Article 1 § 8, Clause 18, the Congress is vested with POWER, "To make ALL laws which SHALL BE necessary and proper for carrying into EXECUTION the foregoing POWERS, and ALL other POWERS vested by this Constitution in the

Government of the United States, or in any Department or Officer thereof".

VII.

Under Article 1 § 9, Clause 7, MONEY SHALL BE drawn from the "Treasury" in consequence of Appropriations made by Law and the Congress has passed such Laws as:

1. Title 31 U.S.C. § 1304 (a) (1) (Necessary amounts are... otherwise authorized by law when - payment is NOT otherwise provided for);
2. Title 31 U.S.C. § 3321 (disbursing authority in the executive branch);
3. Title 31 U.S.C. § 3322 ("ADVANCES");
4. Title 31 U.S.C. § 3326 (waiver of requirements for warrants and "ADVANCES");
5. Title 31 U.S.C. § 3327 (general authority to issue checks and other drafts);
6. Title 31 U.S.C. § 3335 (timely disbursement of Federal funds);
7. Title 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (REDRESS for deprivations of rights under color of law);
8. Title 15 U.S.C. § 15 (injuries to personal property);
9. Title 11 U.S.C. § 101 (5) (A) (U.S. Bankruptcy Code "CLAIM means - right to payment, whether of NOT such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured or unsecured);
10. The Fourteenth Amendment § 4 authorizes that, "The VALIDITY of the PUBLIC DEBT of the United States, authorized by law, 'including' DEBTS incurred for payment of PENSIONS...SHALL NOT be questioned.
11. The Fourteenth amendment § 5 clearly proves that, "The Congress SHALL HAVE POWER to ENFORCE, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this Article", which the congress assertedly has legislated under the cited and applicable authorities herein and hereto.
12. In ULLRICH -v- BOARD OF COUNTY COMM'RS, 234 Kan 782, 676 P2d 127, that is applicable to Michigan under the Full Faith and Credit Clause, the Court ordered, "Thus, if the purpose of an expenditure of public money is legitimate because public, it will NOT be defeated because the EXECUTION of it involves payments to 'INDIVIDUALS', such as Candidate Washington.

13. **OPINION OF JUSTICES TO HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 368 Mass 880, 335 NE2d 362**, that is applicable to Michigan under the Full Faith and Credit Clause, the Court ordered, "Where a proposed governmental expenditure may in some respects result in conferring a benefit upon the public and in other respects in conferring a benefit upon, or in paying money to, PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS, its permissibility will depend upon whether the benefit to the public is primary or direct and not merely incidental. The paramount test is whether the expenditure confers a direct public benefit of a reasonably GENERAL character, that is to say, to a significant part of the public, as distinguished from a remote and theoretical benefit, and whether the aspects of private advantage are reasonably incidental to carrying out a public purpose in a way that is within the discretion of the legislature to choose", proving:

A. The legislature/Congress enacted 28 U.S.C. § 1334 (e) authorizing, "The district court in which a case under Title 11 is commenced or is pending SHALL have EXCLUSIVE jurisdiction of ALL of the property, wherever located, of the debtor as of the COMMENCEMENT of such case, and of property of the estate", and the Delphi Corporation et al., debtors case commenced on October 8, 2005.

B. Under Article 1 § 8, Clause 9, of the U.S. Constitution the Congress SHALL have POWER..."To constitute Tribunals inferior to the Supreme Court", which reasonably vests the Congress with authority to control the funds deposited or, by law, should have been deposited in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York's Bankruptcy division by the debtors; ENACTED was the EXCLUSIVE jurisdiction over the debtors property NOT merely proposed governmental expenditures.

C. According to the administration of the Employees Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA) under 29 U.S.C. §§ 1001 et seq., 1053 et seq., 1056 etc., the Congress ENACTED the payment of Pensions NOT merely proposed these governmental expenditures.

D. Pursuant to 29 U.S.C. § 651 etc., the Congress ENACTED the payment of work related and worker's disability compensation benefits NOT merely proposed these governmental expenditures.

E. ALL of the above public funds have a DIRECT public benefit to ALL citizens which Candidate Washington have lawfully provided private claims to.

VIII.

In **BUCHANAN -v- WARLEY, 245 U.S. 60, 38 S.Ct. 16, 62 L.Ed. 149 (1917 and holding)**, the United States Supreme Court ruled, "But the Fifth Amendment to the Constitution 'DOES' prevent the Federal Government or its agencies from depriving ANY person of his or her property without due process of law; and

the Fourteenth Amendment, and ALL the various state constitutions, prevent ANY action by a state which would accomplish such deprivation". See RASSNER -v- FEDERAL COLLATERAL SOC., 299 Mich. 206, 300 N.W. 45 (1941 and holding).

IX.

The INQUIRIES made to congressman Kildee's office (copies are enclosed) for the past "8" years and continuing proves that agencies of the Federal government including the Department of Treasury, the Internal Revenue Service, the Department of Labor Employee Benefit Security Administration (EBSA), the United States Trustees Program Region #2 for the Southern District of New York, the Federal Housing Administration's General Insurance Fund etc., have deprived Candidate Washington and Family of their constitutional property rights.

1. "PROPERTY in the constitutional sense means not tangible property itself, but rather the right to possess, use, enjoy, and dispose of property". See BUSKEY -v- TOWN OF HANOVER, 133 N.H. 318, 577 A.2d 406 (1990); *NOTE* that ALL cites from states other than Michigan are applicable to Michigan under the Full Faith and Credit Clause without having to repeat the clause.

2. "INDIVIDUALS have a right to own and enjoy PRIVATE property", which the named agencies including Michigan's public officers and agencies have deliberately deprived Candidate Washington and Family to own and enjoy regardless of this candidate having legally hired into the General Motors Corporation on June 13, 1973, almost "35" years ago and this candidate's wife having served two different employers in the same city of Flint, Michigan, for a total of "37" years for a combined sum of "72" years!

3. "...property owners have a right under the Federal Constitution NOT to have the 'government' physically occupy their PROPERTY without due process of law or without just compensation." See BRAY -v- ALEXANDRIA WOMEN'S HEALTH CLINIC, 506 U.S. 263, 113 S.Ct. 753, 122 L.Ed. 2d 34 (1993).

4. In FUENTES -v- SHEVIN, 407 U.S. 67, 92 S.Ct. 1983, 32 L.Ed. 2d 556..., the United States Supreme Court ruled that, "The constitutional prohibition against the deprivation of property without due process of law reflects the high value, embedded in CONSTITUTIONAL and POLITICAL history, that is placed on a person's right to enjoy what is his or her, free of ANY unreasonable governmental interference".

X.

"72" years of 'taxations without representation' is unreasonable governmental interference based on Candidate Washington having NOT received a taxable paycheck from GM, Delphi (nor any self-employment) since September of 1999, yet when INQUIRIES are made to Mr. Kildee's office in October of

2007, the IRS from the Kansas City Center inflicts an additional \$200,000.00 plus on the public records against Candidate Washington and his wife of "27" years which was NOT based on taxable income.

1. Representative Kildee repeatedly will NOT provide representation against these EXACTIONS frauded as taxations,

2. Representative John Conyers would NOT provide judicial access to justice against these EXACTIONS based on his office being informed that the clerk's office of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan etc., have been co-conspiring with certain judges therein to violate Candidate Washington's First Amendment etc., rights to petition the Government for the redress of these grievances by neglecting to accept the \$350.00 filing fee and the filing of JUST Complaints in this court since 2001; Mr. Conyers is Chairman of the House Judiciary Committee.

3. Senator Debbie Stabenow repeatedly refuses to provide representation against these EXACTIONS frauded as lawful taxations.

4. Senator Carl Levin's office is located in the SAME building as the questionable Federal IRS and State Michigan Accounts Receivable Collection System (MARCS) in the McNamara Federal Building in Detroit, Michigan, yet, repeatedly will NOT provide representation against the extortionated EXACTIONS nor the enforcement of ANY laws enacted by the Congress after being requested to do so.

XI.

The United States Attorney's Executive Office NOT the Michigan located office and the Ethics Committees of the House and Senate, have duties to support the Constitution of the United States by OATHS and AFFIRMATIONS sworn to under Article 6 to prosecute and penalize the out of control Voting, Election and Ballot violations conspired in by the Federal elected officials named herein, as well as the State law perpetrators as follows:

1. The State of Michigan has been in a "1" State recession for an estimated two plus years, yet Republican Presidential Candidate Mitt Romney had to make it publicly known; the named Federal public officers in Congress from Michigan, including Representatives John Dingell and Carolyn Kilpatrick nor any of the elected public officers of the State of Michigan has ever confirmed this economic disorder that has to be attributed to the current leaders mismanagements of public funds and illegal holding of their offices.

2. Amendment 20 § 1 of the U.S. Constitution clearly provides for "TERM LIMITATIONS" that have been violated by ALL of the named Federal public officers herein together with the political parties and State election officials who were/are involved in repeatedly putting their names on the ballot at the

expense of the constitutionally required "SUCCESSORS".

3. "SUCCESSORS" is legally defined as, "a person or thing that succeeds or FOLLOWS or a person who succeeds another in office".

4. Representative Dale E. Kildee has NOT had the constitutionally provided "SUCCESSOR" since 1978, prohibitedly election and ballot frauding voters " " years, it is asserted!

5. Representative John Dingell out of Wayne County Michigan has NOT had the constitutionally provided "SUCCESSOR" since 1957, prohibitedly election and ballot frauding voters for "51" years, it is asserted!

6. Representative Carolyn Kilpatrick out of Wayne County, Michigan will ballot fraud voters in the 2008 election if her name is on the ballot instead of a "SUCCESSOR", it is asserted.

7. Senator Carl Levin from Michigan has NOT had the constitutionally provided "SUCCESSOR" since 1981 to prohibitedly election and ballot fraud voters for "26" years, it is asserted.

8. Senator Debbie Stabenow from Michigan was questionably re-elected in an odd number year, after serving her "6" year term which prohibitedly violated the constitutionally provided "SUCCESSOR" from replacing her in office as required. Senator Stabenow has deprived and denied ALL inquiries made to her office on the related subject matters herein that Congressional enactments have provided SELF EXECUTING redresses for.

XII.

Mr. Kildee, Mr. Conyers, Mr. Dingell and Mrs. Kilpatrick are allegedly each in violations of Article 1 § 2, Clause 3, that requires in part, "...The Number of Representatives SHALL NOT exceed 'ONE' for every "THIRTY THOUSAND", yet each of these named U.S. Representatives are fraudulently representing more than "600,000" citizens each, proving;

1. Taxations without representation!

2. If "30,000" constituents are being represented, which "570,000" plus in each official's district are NOT being represented?

3. That the Senate Committee on the Judiciary amending Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act clearly enumerated factors or violations for courts to consider and such violations by these officers are related to:

A. The history of official voting-related discriminations in the state and political subdivisions and the named officers discriminations encompasses the entire State which the two named senators are voter frauding within, as well as the specific Congressional districts that each one of the named

U.S. Representatives, severally and separately, are ballot, election, and voter frauding also, the same as the two senators are, allegedly.

B. The city of Flint, Michigan has a population exceeding 120,000 which entitles it to "4" United States Representatives when applying the "ONE" for "EVERY 30,000" compliance requirements of Article 1 § 2, Clause 3; redistricting Mr. Kildee into the prohibited 'UNUSUALLY LARGE ELECTION DISTRICT' that includes a majority of WHITE CITIZENS in the four counties of Genesee, Bay, Saginaw and Tuscola, is one of the Violating Factors the Senate Committee on the Judiciary suggested are voting practices or procedures that tend to enhance the opportunity for discriminations against the black minority group particularly since Flint is a majority BLACK city and Candidate Washington is black.

C. According to public records, NOT once in "151" years of the establishment of Flint as a city, has a black candidate been elected to a United States office from Flint's jurisdiction, nor in the "172" years establishment of the Genesee County jurisdiction that Flint is the largest city in, which is another Section 2 of the amended Voting Rights Act factors specified by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary for courts to consider as a violation.

D. Congressman Kildee is Chairman of "3" committees relating to Education, Health and Employment; according to the Senate Committee on the Judiciary another factor specified for the courts to consider as a violation includes, "the extent to which minority group members bear the effects of discriminations in areas such as 'education', 'employment', and 'health', which hinder their ability to participate effectively in the political process", and the connections of Mr. Kildee's committees to the great losses being suffered by blacks in 'education', 'employment' and 'health' in this Congressional district have direct and deliberate causes it is alleged.

E. Mr. Kildee, as chairman and co-chairman of committees on Employment, Labor, Pensions and the Congressional Automotive Caucus, allegedly is the direct and deliberate causes of Candidate Washington being extorted, frauded, racketeered etc., out of 100% of ALL compensations for "8" years to survive on that have been lawfully earned over a "35" year period of service to the General Motors and Delphi Corporations that are INSEPARABLE 'personal funds' that could be used to finance this campaign to be elected to the U.S. House to help reverse some of the massive failures that ALL citizens in this political subdivision are unnecessarily suffering from.

F. Candidate Washington reserves for filing other related issues until a future date.
