Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) discloses a disbursement(s) for "fraudulent disbursement - see memo text" totaling \$10,000. This transaction(s) appears to be related to an apparent unauthorized disbursement of Committee funds.

The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, "During the Post-General reporting period, an unknown individual(s) created, forged and cashed two fictitious PAC checks totaling \$10,000. These fictitious checks were presented for payment on 11/15/2022 and 11/25/2022. The Committee notified Chain Bridge Bank of the issue on 11/29/2022 and is working to have these fraudulent transactions returned to the Committee. This report documents the disbursement of fraudulent funds during the Post-General reporting period." Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding this apparent improper use of Committee funds, any further clarifying information that you can provide will be taken into consideration. (11 CFR §102.9, 102.15, and 104.3)

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will**

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**not be considered.**
