Dear Ms. Denbaas:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-The identification of each contributor, including an adequate occupation and name of employer for each, must be provided if the person has contributed in excess of \$200 in the aggregate during the calendar year. Please amend Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) for each name of employer inadequately identified by using apparent names of departments/divisions.

-Schedule A of your report discloses apparent earmarked contributions. However, your committee has not provided a corresponding Schedule B which is necessary when making earmarked contributions. Please be advised, if the earmarked contributions passed through your committee's account, then a notation must be made which states this and each must be itemized on Schedules A and B, regardless of the amount. However, if the earmarked contributions were forwarded in the form of the contributor's check, then a notation must be made which states this and they should be disclosed as MEMO entries on Schedules A and B. For disclosure purposes, the name and mailing address for each contributor must be provided and where the contribution exceeds \$200, the individual's occupation and name of employer must also be itemized. Please amend

your report accordingly. 11 CFR §110.6(c)(1)(iv)

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designation and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
