Dear Mr. Chairman:


This is to provide the Commission with the required written notification of a new affiliate relationship between the ENRON Political Action Committee (ID #C0010410) of ENRON Corp. at 1400 Smith Street, Houston, Texas and the Bipartisan Committee for Effective Government-Federal (ID #C00082008) of Portland General Electric Company, a subsidiary of Portland General Corporation, at 121 S.W. Salmon Street, Portland, Oregon. The affiliate relationship is the result of a merger between our two companies completed on July 1, 1997.

This written notification of an affiliate relationship is required under the existing FEC guidelines, and we request that our statement of organization be amended accordingly to reflect this change. For the interest of the Commission, the public at large and our employees we would like to declare our intent to, by the end of this year, dissolve the federal PAC of Portland General Electric Company by expending to candidates, or transferring to the ENRON Corp. PAC, any remaining balances, and begin having contributions previously made by Portland General employees to the PGE PAC to instead accrue to the ENRON PAC.

It is our clear understanding that until the Portland General PAC is terminated that under the affiliate relationship with ENRON all employee solicitations, contributions, and expenditures to candidates are treated as one, and are subject to the same limitations thereof.
