The purpose of this letter is to inform you and the public that effective Thursday, December 27, 2012, I am no longer a candidate in the 2014 election for the 5<sup>th</sup> District of Massachusetts in the United States House of Representatives. I will no longer seek nomination or election to the United States House of Representatives, and have ceased to conduct campaign activities with respect to the aforementioned election.

I am now a candidate for the United States Senate in the 2013 special election and the 2014 election and will henceforth be conducting campaign activities only in pursuit of that office. I will also amend my Statement of Organization to change the office sought and will file a Statement of Candidacy with the Secretary of the Senate.
