This notice is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. The beginning cash balance of this report does not equal the ending balance of your Amended Year-End Report (11/26/24 - 12/31/24), received 2/12/25. Please correct this discrepancy and amend all subsequent report(s) that may be affected by the correction. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b))
2. Schedule A supporting Line 16 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses a refund of a contribution made to "Smithfield Foods, Inc. PAC." However, it appears that this contribution was not previously reported by your committee. Please amend the appropriate reports(s) to disclose the original contribution or provide clarifying information. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) and 11 CFR § 104.3(a) & (b))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
