Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following item:

-The beginning cash balance of this report should equal the ending balance of your April Quarterly Report (1/1/09 – 3/31/09). Please clarify this discrepancy and amend any subsequent report(s) that may be affected by this correction. The Commission notes that you have submitted a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (FEC Form 99) on June 10, 2009, stating, "As of March 31, 2009, The Doctors Company's Federal DOCPAC had a positive checking account balance or cash on hand of \$41,215.17." The Commission further notes that you have submitted a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (FEC Form 99) on August 10, 2009, stating, "As of June 30, 2009, The Doctors Company's Federal DOCPAC had a positive checking account balance or cash on hand of \$43,856.88." Please be advised that when amending information that affects entries on a report, you must amend the actual report to reflect any additions, changes or deletions. This includes but is not limited to, issues relating to mathematical calculations. The use of a Miscellaneous Text Submission (F99) is for narrative responses that do not affect actual entries within a report. Please clarify this discrepancy and amend any subsequent report(s) that may be affected by this correction.

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Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
