Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests clarification concerning the disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in further Commission review. Additional information is requested for the following item(s):

Your most recent report discloses a significant amount of residual cash on hand. Please explain the committee's intended use of the residual campaign funds. If the candidate intends to terminate the committee, redesignate the committee as a principal campaign committee for a future election or convert it to a multicandidate political committee, please note this for the public record.

Be aware that committee assets, including cash-on-hand, may not be converted to personal use. Personal use is any use of funds in a campaign account of a present or former candidate to fulfill a commitment, obligation or expense of any person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's campaign or duties as a federal office holder. 11 CFR §113.1.

In addition to defraying expenses in connection with a campaign for federal office, the funds in a campaign account may be used to defray the costs of winding down the campaign, including winding down the office of a former federal officeholder for a period of six months after they leave office. 11 CFR §113.2. A campaign committee that no longer receives any contributions or makes any disbursements that would otherwise qualify it as a political committee may terminate, provided that such committee has no outstanding debts or obligations. The committee may file a termination report or request with the Commission, providing a statement concerning the disposition of residual funds. 11 CFR §102.3.
