Dear Commission:

This Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (Form 99) is filed by Friends of Michael Bouchard Inc (C00925743) in response to the Request for Additional Information (RFAI RQ-2, Image# 202602050300336191) dated February 5, 2026, concerning apparent excessive contributions from two individual contributors disclosed on Schedule A of our Year-End Report covering the period October 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

The Committee has reviewed the flagged contributions and confirms that all excessive amounts have been resolved through a combination of reattributions, redesignations, and refunds, each completed within 60 days of receipt, as described below. Each contributor is now within the applicable contribution limits of \$3,500 per election pursuant to 52 U.S.C. Section 30116(a) and 11 CFR Section 110.1(b).

JOHNSON, DAVID V Clarkston, MI

Mr. Johnson made two contributions during the reporting period: a \$10,000 contribution by check on December 29, 2025, and a \$5,000 contribution via WinRed earmark on December 29, 2025. The Committee took the following corrective actions, all within 60 days of receipt:

(a) Reattribution: \$5,000 of the \$10,000 check contribution was reattributed from David V Johnson to his spouse, Pam Johnson, with signed written authorization from both contributors, in accordance with 11 CFR Section 110.1(k)(3). (Transaction IDs A-1019 and A-1008, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(b) Redesignation: \$1,500 of David V Johnson's remaining \$5,000 was redesignated from the 2026 Primary election to the 2026 General election, with signed written authorization from the contributor, in accordance with 11 CFR ? 110.1(b)(5). (Transaction IDs A-1020 and A-1021, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(c) Redesignation: \$1,500 of Pam Johnson's reattributed \$5,000 was redesignated from the 2026 Primary election to the 2026 General election, with signed written authorization. (Transaction IDs A-1012 and A-1013, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(d) Refund: The \$5,000 WinRed earmark contribution was refunded in full on January 15, 2026 via WinRed. This refund will be disclosed on Schedule B, Line 20(a) of the Committee's April 15 Quarterly Report (Q1 2026) covering the period in which the refund was made.

After all corrective actions, the contributions from the Johnson household are allocated as follows:

David V Johnson: \$3,500 (Primary 2026), \$1,500 (General 2026) Total: \$5,000
Pam Johnson: \$3,500 (Primary 2026), \$1,500 (General 2026) Total: \$5,000

Both contributors are within the applicable per-election limits.

PERENIC, FRED Franklin, MI

Mr. Perenic made three contributions during the reporting period: two contributions of \$7,000 each via WinRed earmark on December 19, 2025, and a third contribution of \$7,000 via WinRed earmark on December 26, 2025. The Committee took the following corrective actions, all within 60 days of receipt:

(a) Reattribution: \$7,000 (one full contribution) was reattributed from Fred Perenic to his spouse, Lynn Perenic, with signed written authorization from both contributors, in accordance with 11 CFR Section 110.1(k)(3). (Transaction IDs

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A-1015 and A-1014, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(b) Redesignation: \$3,500 of Fred Perenic's remaining \$7,000 contribution was redesignated from the 2026 Primary election to the 2026 General election, with signed written authorization. (Transaction IDs A-814 and A-813, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(c) Redesignation: \$3,500 of Lynn Perenic's reattributed \$7,000 contribution was redesignated from the 2026 Primary election to the 2026 General election, with signed written authorization. (Transaction IDs A-1017 and A-1016, reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the Year-End Report.)

(d) Refund: The third contribution of \$7,000 received on December 26, 2025 was refunded in full on January 6, 2026 via WinRed. This refund will be disclosed on Schedule B, Line 20(a) of the Committee's April 15 Quarterly Report (Q1 2026) covering the period in which the refund was made.

After all corrective actions, the contributions from the Perenic household are allocated as follows:

Fred Perenic: \$3,500 (Primary 2026), \$3,500 (General 2026) Total: \$7,000

Lynn Perenic: \$3,500 (Primary 2026), \$3,500 (General 2026) Total: \$7,000

Both contributors are within the applicable per-election limits.

The Committee takes its compliance obligations seriously and has implemented procedures to identify and timely resolve any contributions that exceed the applicable limits. The Committee retains signed written authorizations for all reattributions and redesignations referenced above, and records of all refunds issued, as required by 11 CFR Section 104.14(b). The refunds described above will be fully itemized on the Committee's April 15 Quarterly Report (Q1 2026).
