This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report to clarify the following description(s): "ATM withdrawl - payment for consulting services," "ATM withdrawl: reimbursement for consulting work," "Debit: canvassing payment," "Debit: canvassing payments," "Debit: withdrawl for payment for canvassing team," "Debit: withrawl payment to canvassing team," and "Withdrawl - payment for services." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursement, please refer to 11 CFR 104.3(b)(3)(i).

2. Please amend your report to include the missing information and clearly identify on the Schedule B, which reimbursement each memo entry relates to. If itemization is not necessary, you must indicate so in an amendment

3. Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) discloses disbursements to petty cash for "ATM: withdrawl payment for canvassing," "ATM withdrawl - payment for consulting services," "ATM withdrawl: reimbursement for consulting work," "Debit: withrawl payment to canvassing team," and "Withdrawl - payment for services." Please be advised that cash disbursements to any person or vendor for any single purchase or transaction may not exceed \$100. If payments to the original vendor exceed \$200 in a calendar year, a memo entry including the name of the original vendor as well as address, date, amount, and purpose of the original purchase must be provided. Please amend your report to include the missing information or provide clarifying information if memo items are not required. (52 U.S.C. §30102(h)(2) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 432(h)(2)) and 11 CFR §102.11)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
