Dear Sarah,

This letter is in reference to your Request for Additional Information dated February 26, 2025. Please see the below answers to your identified items as well as our amended Post-General 2024 report.

- 1. When the initial Post-General 2024 FEC report was filed, there were invoices that had not yet been appropriately communicated through the proper channels for invoice processing. Certain aging invoices that fell into the category of debt for the Post General time frame. Once the compliance firm was alerted to the aging invoices, the Post General report was amended to reflect this debt.
2. The identified individuals who were over the contribution limit had refunds issued in March 2025. These refunds will appear on the April Monthly report filed on April 20th.
3. The \$28,376.82 transfer from the "DNC SERVICES CORP / DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL COMMITTEE" had joint fundraising transactions attached that were improperly recorded as contribution type "Monetary Contribution". They have been amended to properly reflect contribution type "Joint Fundraising Allocation". This amendment resulted in a decrease to 11ai itemized receipts by \$11499.75 and a decrease to 11aia unitemized receipts by \$2280. This in turn resulted in a decreased closing COH balance by \$13,779.75.
4. The identified PAC that was over the contribution limit had a refund issued in March 2025. That refund will appear on the April Monthly report filed on April 20th.
5. All LLC contributions have been amended to be allocated to individual members.
6. These incoming transactions were incorrectly reported as offsets to operating expenditures, when they should have been "Other Receipts/Miscellaneous" The report has been amended to correct this error.
7. The identified inadequate purposes have been amended to adequate purposes.
