Dear Mr. Tallman:

As we discussed on the telephone on March 8, 1996, when filing our reports, the status of DermPAC should have been changed to that of a Multi-Candidate Status to reflect the way in which our PAC operates. Our PAC has been in operation for a period of more than six months with more than 50 donors and we have made contributions to more than five candidates.

In an effort to allow our PAC to operate properly within the FEC guidelines and the way in which we would like to operate, I am enclosing the FEC form 1M, an amended schedule for your review and I would like to have DermPAC formally change its status to that of a Multi-Candidate PAC as soon as possible.

DermPAC became eligible for Multi-Candidate Status on March 31, 1995. I believe we have operated in conformance with the law. DermPAC records on Schedule B a check whenever it is issued. Occasionally, when a check is issued and sent to a DermPAC member to be presented personally to the candidate, the check is not timely delivered to the candidate as intended. However, DermPAC may not become aware of this fact for a number of weeks.

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

This is what occurred with the \$500 check issued to the Coburn for Congress Committee on 1/27/95. That check was never cashed and was voided on 3/6/95, as indicated by the notation "Voided Check" under "Purpose of Disbursement" and the minus sign before the \$500 amount shown on that date. A new check was issued on 3/10/95 for \$500, the only amount paid to or for Coburn before March 31, 1995. If there is a clearer way to record such transactions on Schedule B please advise me so we can avoid this problem in the future. It may happen that the voiding and re-issue of a check may occur after a Schedule B is filed.

If we have created extra work for you, we apologize and hope that we have straightened out this problem.
