Dear Ms. Vivian:

We are responding to your letter dated February 23 (RFAI) regarding the 2025 Year-End Report. As next explained, none of the receipts that the RFAI inquires about were "contributions originally intended for the non-federal account." All dates below pertain to 2025.

The August 1 transfer of \$2,823.79 to 1199 National Benefit Fund (also known as 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Benefit Fund): This was received on June 11 by an ACH transfer from an employer of members of the Committee's connected organization, 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East ("1199 SEIU"), as periodic contributions to this employee benefit fund pursuant to the employer's collective bargaining agreement with 1199 SEIU. The employer inadvertently transferred this amount to the Committee's account, an error that the Committee subsequently determined and corrected as part of its regular review of receipts. The Committee disclosed this receipt on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Mid-Year Report. The Committee is amending that report in order to itemize this receipt instead on Line 17.

The August 1 transfer of \$15 to 1199 SEIU: This amount was received on May 28 from an employer of members of 1199 SEIU as an incoming ACH credit of payroll-deducted 1199 SEIU dues. The employer inadvertently transferred this amount to the Committee's account, an error that the Committee subsequently determined and corrected as part of its regular review of receipts. The Committee disclosed this receipt on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Mid-Year Report. The Committee is also amending that report in order to disclose this receipt instead on Line 17.

The August 22 transfer of \$620 to 1199 SEIU: This amount was received on July 8 by check from an employer of members of 1199 SEIU as payroll-deducted 1199 SEIU dues. This check was inadvertently deposited in the Committee's account, an error that the Committee subsequently determined and corrected as part of its regular review of receipts. The Committee disclosed this receipt on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Year-End Report. The Committee is amending that report in order to disclose this receipt instead on Line 17.

The November 5 transfer of \$9,755 to 1199 SEIU: This amount is the total of the following three incoming money transfers of payroll-deducted 1199 SEIU dues from an employer of members of 1199 SEIU: \$3,200 on September 18, \$3,200 on October 9, and \$3,555 on October 16. The employer inadvertently transferred these amounts to the Committee's account, errors that the Committee subsequently determined and corrected as part of its regular review of receipts. The Committee disclosed these receipts on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Year-End Report. The Committee is also amending that report in order to disclose this receipt instead on Line 17.

The December 22 transfer of \$3,065 to 1199 SEIU: This amount was received on November 17 as an incoming money transfer of payroll-deducted 1199 SEIU dues from an employer of members of 1199 SEIU. The employer inadvertently transferred this amount to the Committee's account, an error that the Committee subsequently determined and corrected as part of its regular review of receipts. The Committee disclosed this receipt on Line 11(a)(ii) of the Year-End Report. The Committee is also amending that report in order to disclose this receipt instead on Line 17.

The Committee is not itemizing the Line 17 receipts of misdeposited member dues. We believe that such remittances should not be itemized as coming from the employer any more than a collecting agent remitting contributions should be itemized rather than the individual contributors whose contributions the collecting agent simply forwards to the Committee. But unlike contributions to the Committee, these dues were not volitional payments by members to the Committee, so the members should not be itemized.
